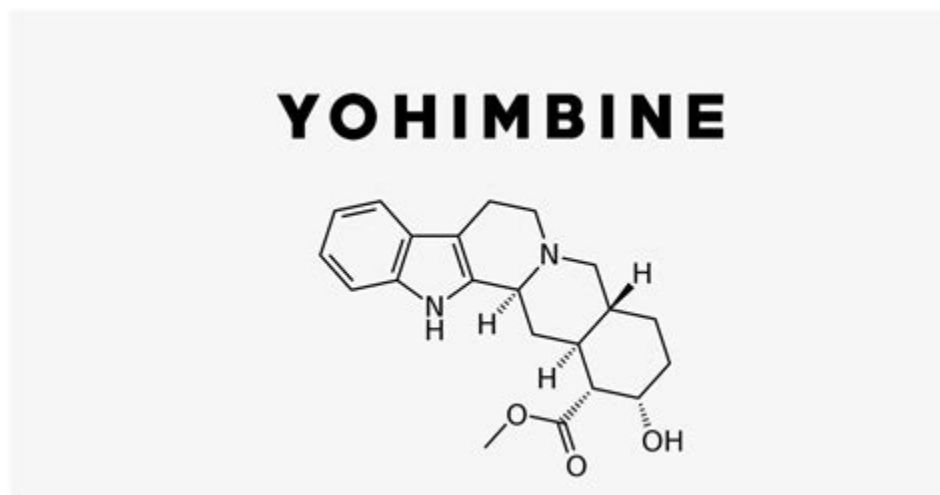

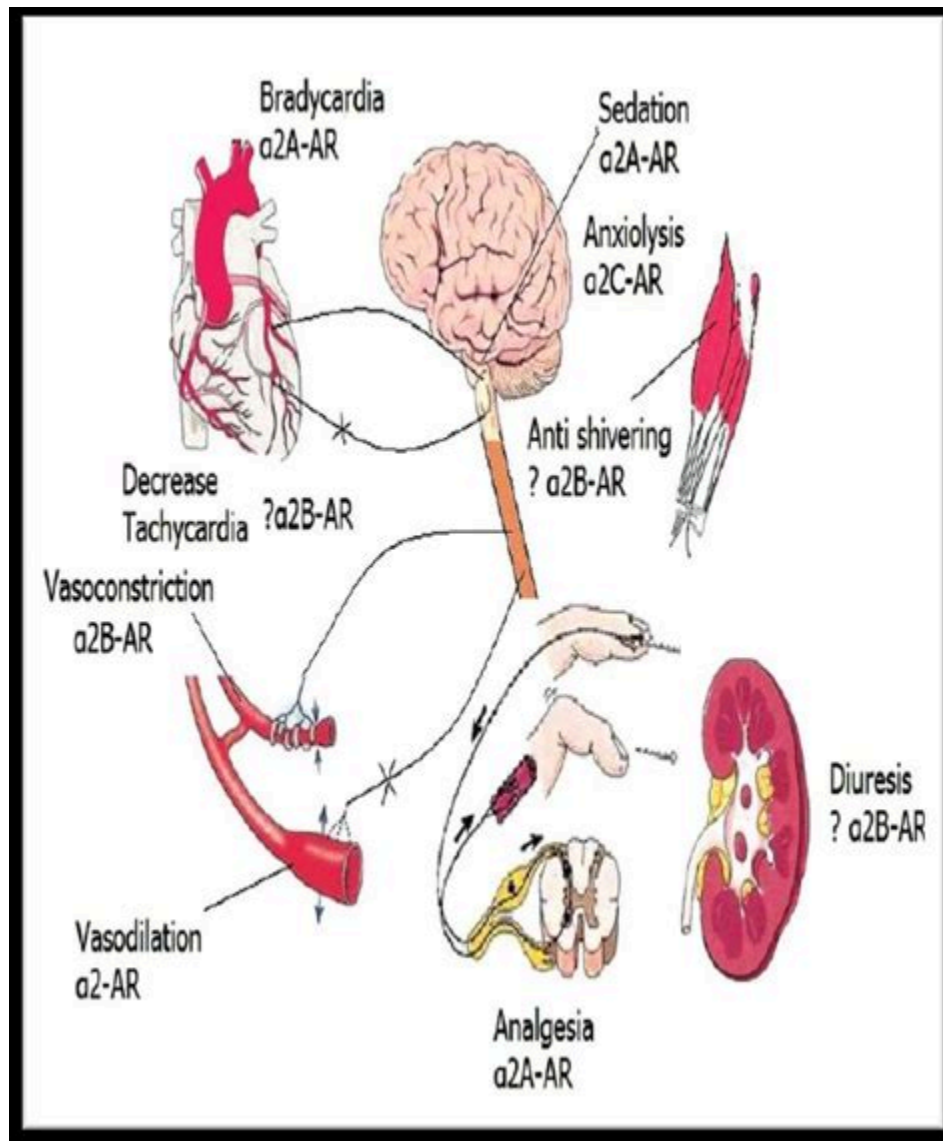

Yohimbine (/j oʊ ' h ɪ m b iː n /), also known as quebrachine, is an indole alkaloid derived from the bark of the African tree *Pausinystalia johimbe*; also from the bark of the unrelated South American tree *Aspidosperma quebracho-blanco*. Yohimbine is an α 2-adrenergic receptor antagonist, and has been used in a variety of research projects. It is a veterinary drug used to reverse sedation .

Medically, yohimbine is a pre-synaptic alpha-2-adrenergic blocking agent, also referred to as an alpha 2-adrenergic antagonist. This action increases sympathetic nervous system activity, and can result in increasing the amounts of epinephrine (also known as adrenaline) and norepinephrine in the blood stream.
