

How much will Clomid raise testosterone? Clomid has been shown to raise T levels effectively. In one small study involving 22 men with infertility, a daily dose of 25 mg of clomiphene significantly increased testosterone levels—by 99. 2% on average (Liao, 2022).


Second, Clomid is great, even for long-term treatment. Studies have shown that taking clomid for up to 15 months is safe and effective at helping improve testosterone levels, improve male factor infertility, and maintain testosterone levels up for as long as 3 years. 
You will generally be asked to take Clomid starting on day 3 to 5 of your cycle and continue to take it at the same time every day for 5 days. You will likely be started on a low dose of Clomid, such as 50 mg a day. This is to reduce the likelihood of developing cysts, side effects, and multiple pregnancies.


