



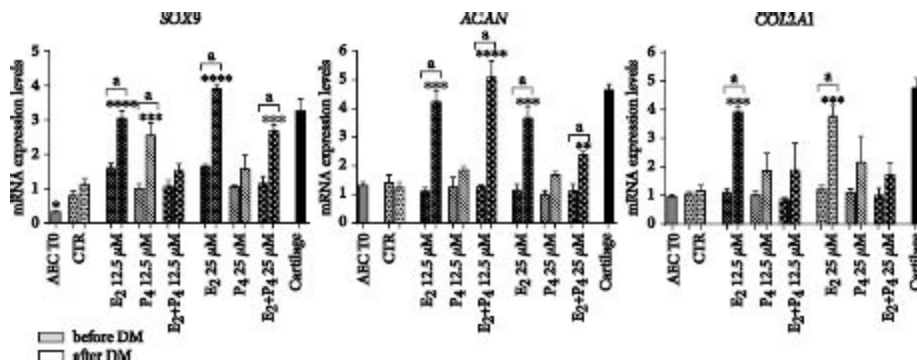

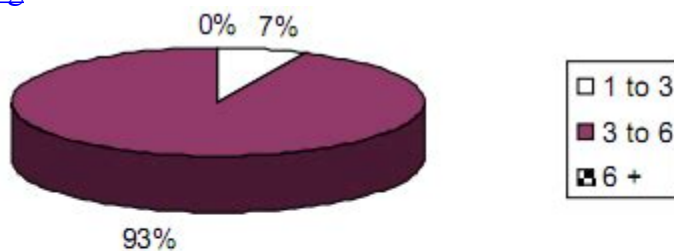


Figure 1 Number of AAS abuse by females (%).

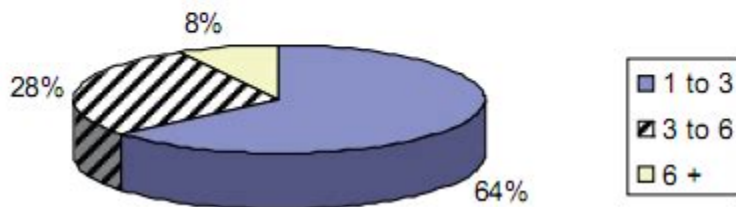


Figure 2 Number of AAS abuse by males (%).
