What are the risks of HGH treatment?

- Carpal tunnel syndrome.
- Increased insulin resistance.
- Type 2 diabetes.
- Swelling in the arms and legs (edema)
- Joint and muscle pain.
- For men, enlargement of breast tissue (gynecomastia)
- Increased risk of certain cancers.

Is Human Growth Hormone therapy safe?

GH treatment is a **safe**, effective way to treat growth hormone deficiency, Turner Syndrome, and a few other conditions associated with short stature.

What happens if you take growth hormone?

Long-term use of HGH injections can cause a condition called **acromegaly**. Adults cannot grow taller by using the synthetic growth hormone. High doses will thicken the person's bones instead of lengthening them. People with acromegaly will experience an overgrowth of bones, particularly in the hands, feet, and face.

Does HGH shorten your life?

Other research has shown that people with low levels of HGH due to surgical or radiation damage to the pituitary gland that makes HGH have **increased risk of cardiovascular disease**, a factor that can shorten life span.



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Does HGH damage your liver?

HGH prompts the liver and other organs to make IGF-1, which affects many tissues and organs in the body. Studies usually measure IGF-1 rather than growth hormone directly because IGF-1 levels remain more constant.

Is HGH safe for females?
