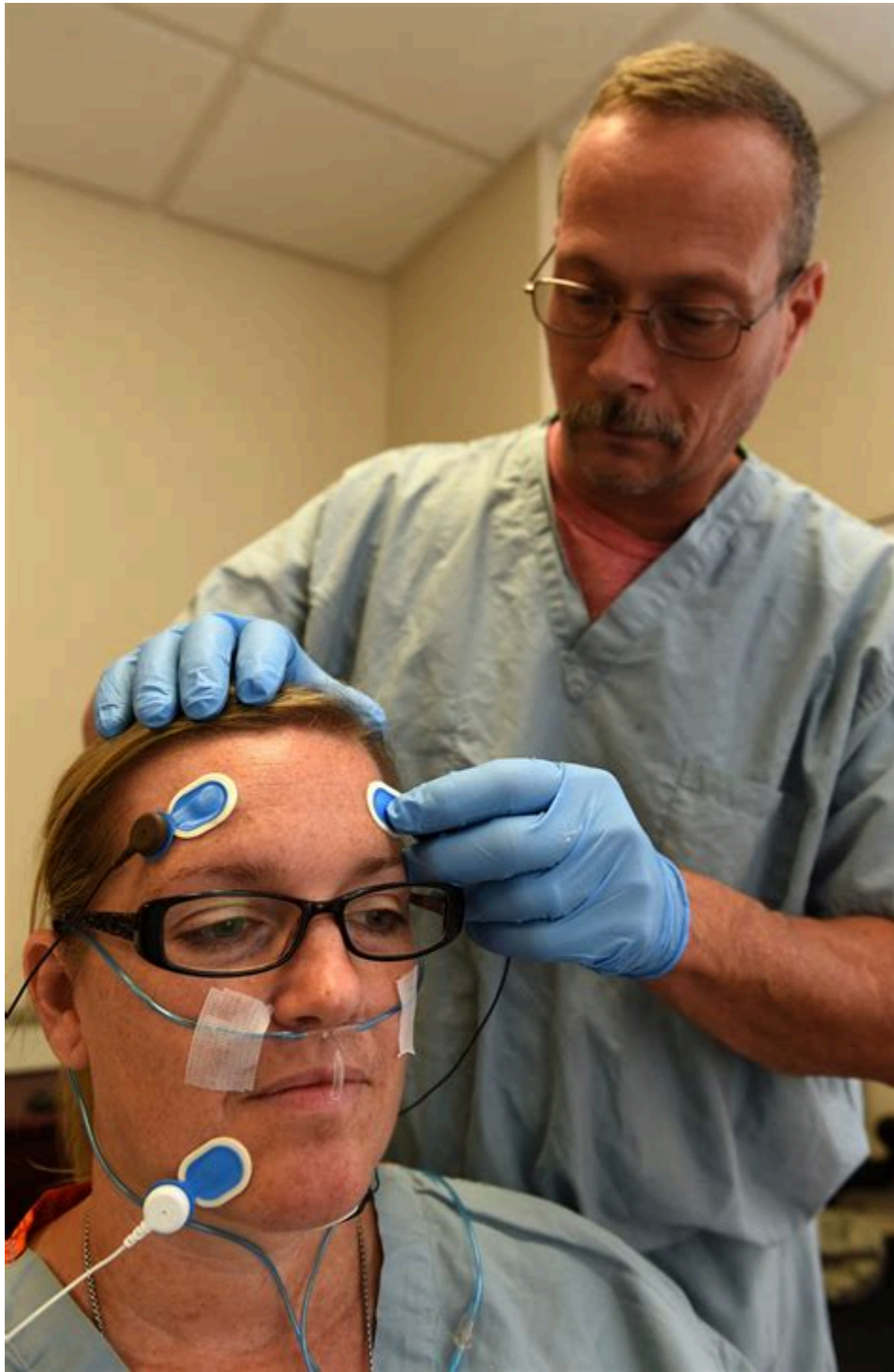

Patients prescribed inhaled albuterol and inhaled corticosteroids had an increased risk of adverse gastrointestinal events compared to patients prescribed only albuterol [hazard ratio 1.26 (95% confidence interval 1.02 to 1.56)] after controlling for potential confounders.

INTRODUCTION. The passage of gastric contents into the esophagus (gastroesophageal reflux) is a normal physiologic process. Most episodes are brief and do not cause symptoms, esophageal injury, or other complications. Risk of Adverse Gastrointestinal Events from Inhaled Corticosteroids

Nausea

- Eat crackers, apples, mint, ginger-based drinks 30 min after GLP-1 RA
- Avoid strong smells

Vomiting

- Generous hydration
- More frequent meals, in smaller amounts

Diarrhoea

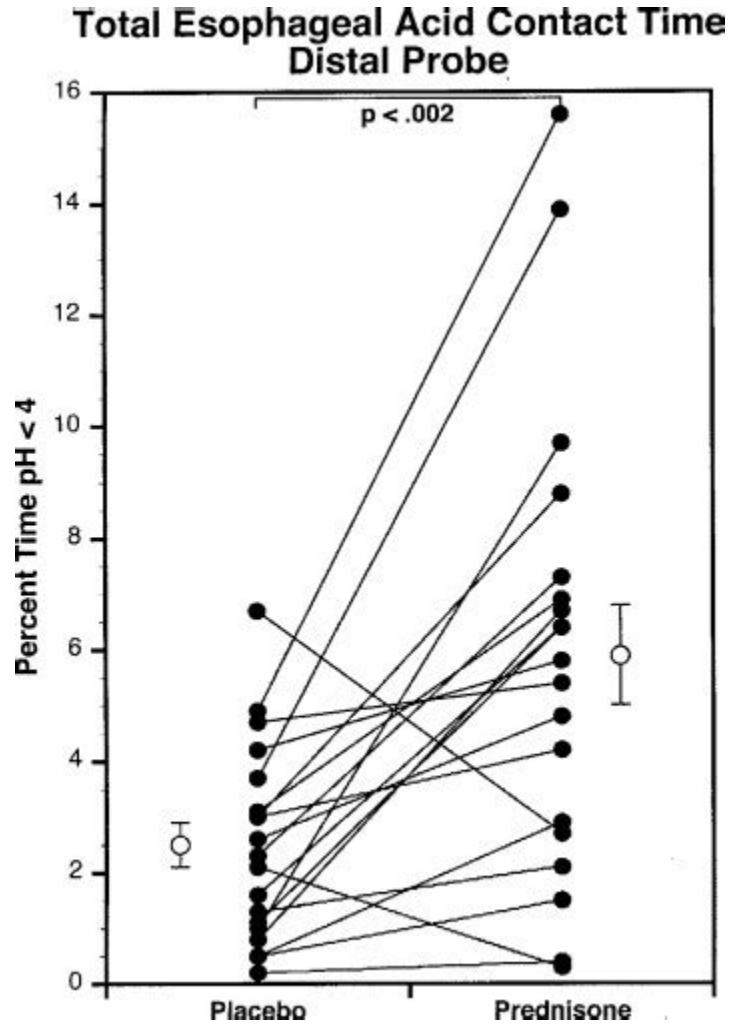
- Generous hydration (water, lemon, bicarbonate)
- No sport drinks
- No high fibre content foods (gradually restore them upon improvement)*
- Yes: chicken broth, rice, carrots, ripe peeled fruit, baked fruit
- No: dairy products, laxatives, coffee, alcohol, soft drinks, very cold/hot foods, products with "ol"-ending sweeteners

Constipation

- Enough fiber in diet
- Increase physical activity
- Healthy, balanced diet
- Generous hydration (water, sugar-free liquids)

What is prednisone? Prednisone is a strong anti-inflammatory steroid and jack-of-all-trades that is prescribed to treat conditions such as: Poison ivy. Sore throat. Acid reflux is an **uncomfortable burning sensation in the chest and throat** that occurs when stomach acid backtracks from the stomach into the esophagus.

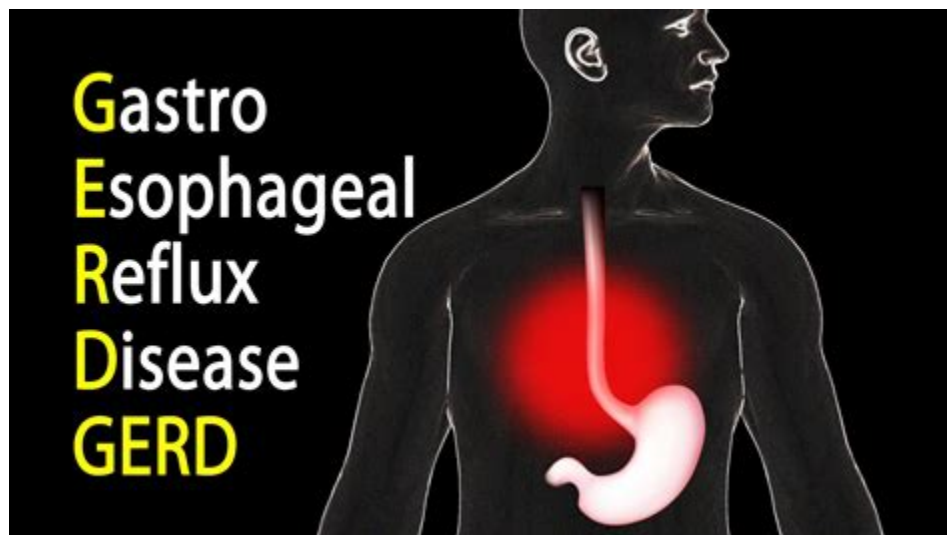
Identifying Acid Reflux:

- **ACID REFLUX:** Backflow of acid from the stomach into the esophagus; usually passes quickly
- **HEARTBURN:** Fiery sensation around the heart or behind the breastbone caused by acid reflux
- **GERD:** Chronic or severe acid reflux; occurs more than twice a week, interfering with daily life

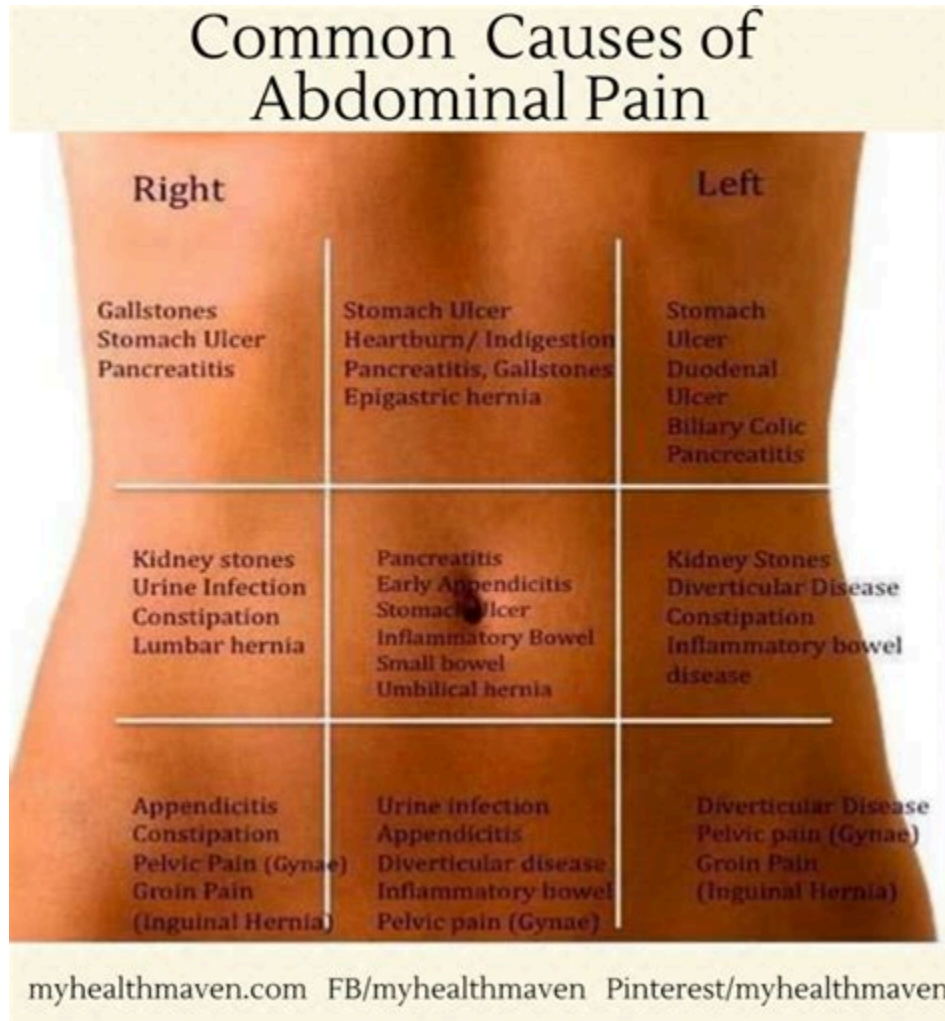

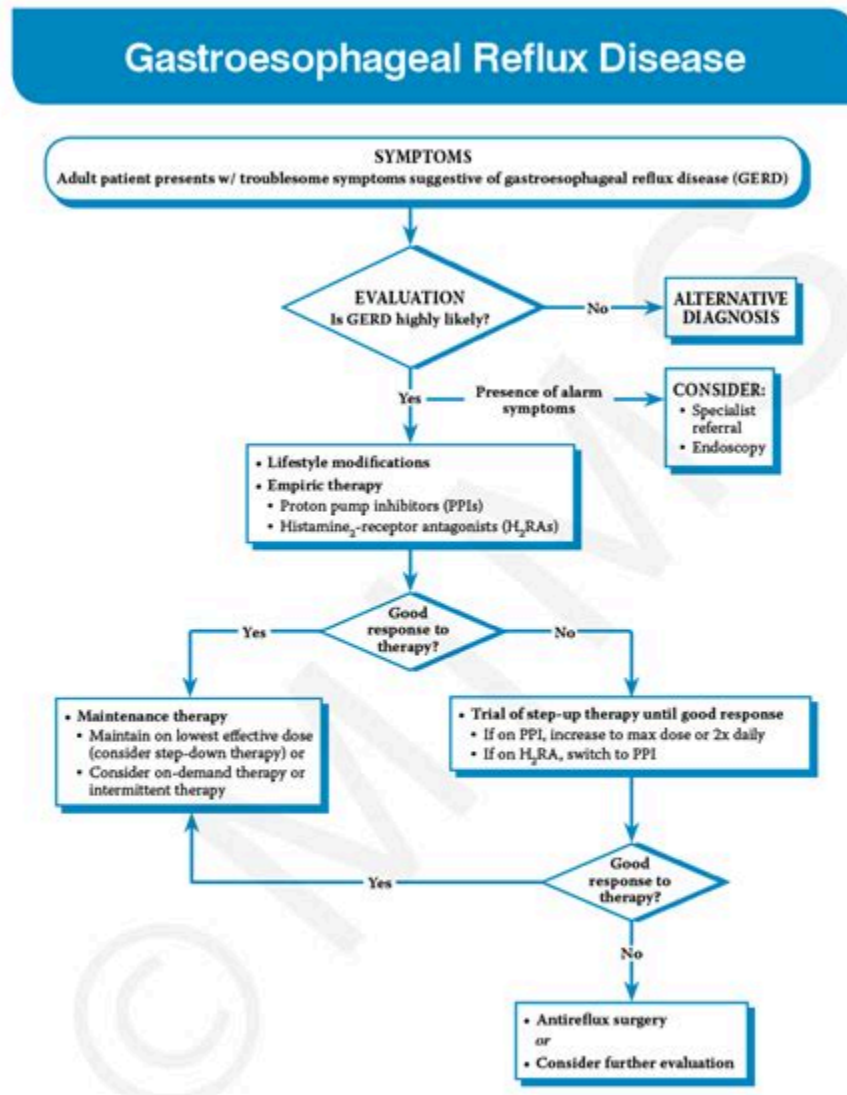
Prednisone, a corticosteroid medication used to treat various inflammatory conditions (3) can cause acid reflux by stimulating the release of gastrin (4). Gastrin is the hormone that promotes stomach acid secretion. This results in acid reflux in the patient. Prednisone may also enhance the activity of the parietal cells of the stomach (5).

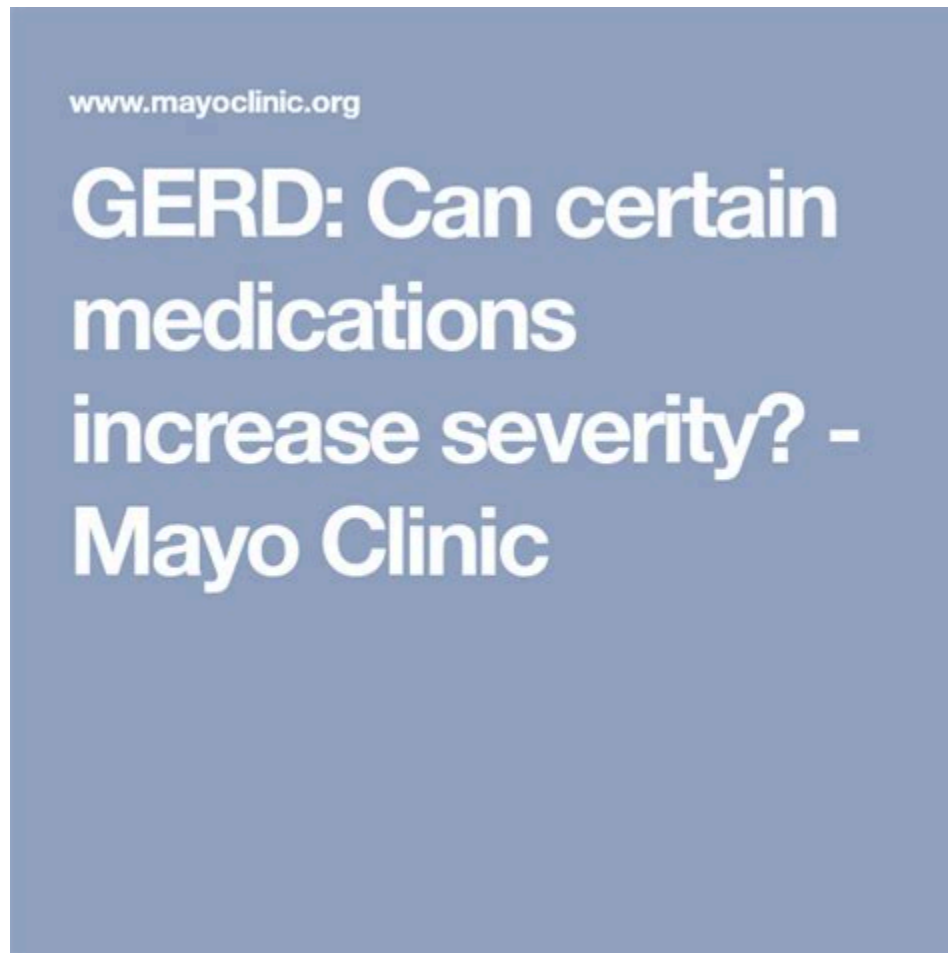

8 Prednisone Side Effects + How to Minimize Them



Steroids are medications that reduce inflammation but they also cause a number of side effects including acid reflux (2). Steroids can lead to acid reflux or heartburn by relaxing the lower oesophageal sphincter (1). The lower oesophageal is the muscle that helps to keep stomach acid from flowing back up n to the oesophagus.

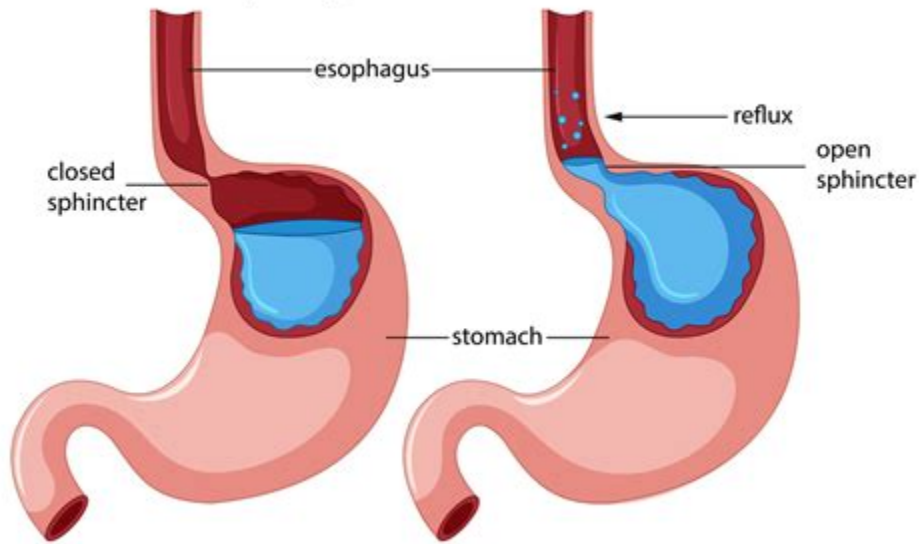

Treatment for reflux esophagitis may include: Nonprescription treatments. These include antacids (Maalox, Mylanta, others); medicines that reduce acid production, called H-2-receptor blockers, such as cimetidine (Tagamet HB); and medicines that block acid production and heal the esophagus, called proton pump inhibitors.

What is GERD? GERD stands for gastroesophageal reflux disease. This is the medical term for chronic acid reflux in your esophagus. Acid reflux is considered chronic when you've had it at least twice a week for several weeks. Temporary conditions can cause temporary acid reflux. But GERD is a constant, mechanical problem.

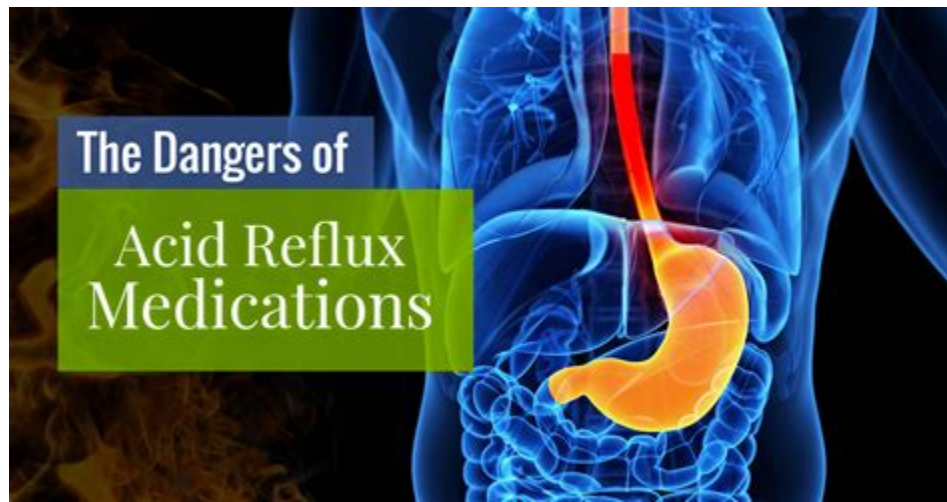
