Virtually all departments had written policies and procedures for conducting tests in cases of suspected drug abuse by officers, and 73 percent tested applicants. 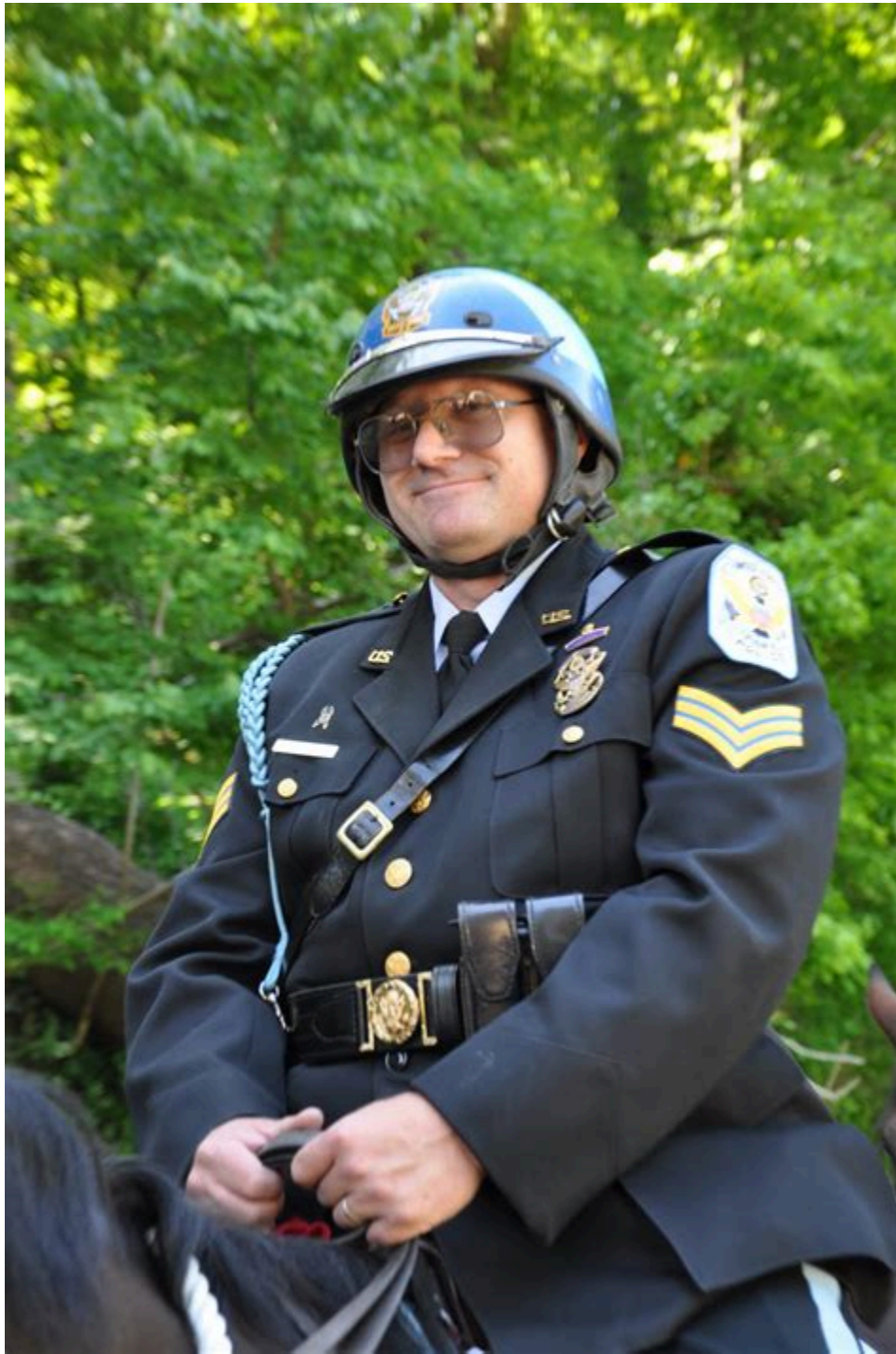

To become a police officer, applicants must have a negative test result. Urine samples are frequently taken in the same area where the candidate is applying for the job. For the initial test, an FDA-approved immunoassay will be employed. This is often a urine drug test cup that may detect up to 12 different substances of abuse.

TOP POLICE BACKGROUND CHECK DISQUALIFIERS

FELONY CONVICTIONS

This is a fairly straightforward part of the process. If there is a felony conviction in the candidate's criminal record, their application will most likely stop there.



SERIOUS MISDEMEANORS

The definition of a serious misdemeanor isn't as precise as that of a felony, and it often changes from agency to agency. However, crimes such as driving under the influence, assault, and perjury are almost always guaranteed to disqualify a candidate.



UNREPORTED PAST CRIMES

If a candidate has committed a crime but never faced arrest or conviction because of it, that information can still come up in a police background check. Agencies often take undetected or unreported crimes as seriously as actual convictions.



DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

This is a crime that stands in complete contrast to the values and responsibilities of a police force. If an officer has a history of domestic violence, the public can't trust them to protect victims of that same crime. If any incident of domestic violence appears on a candidate's record, the agency will automatically ban them from the force.



CURRENT OR PAST DRUG USE



The antiquated system of having applicants fill out applications and then follow a testing period for written tests, oral boards, physical agility and medical screening, drug testing, backgrounds, polygraph and psychological testing, is unappealing to today's candidates. Technology can shorten the police recruit application process.
