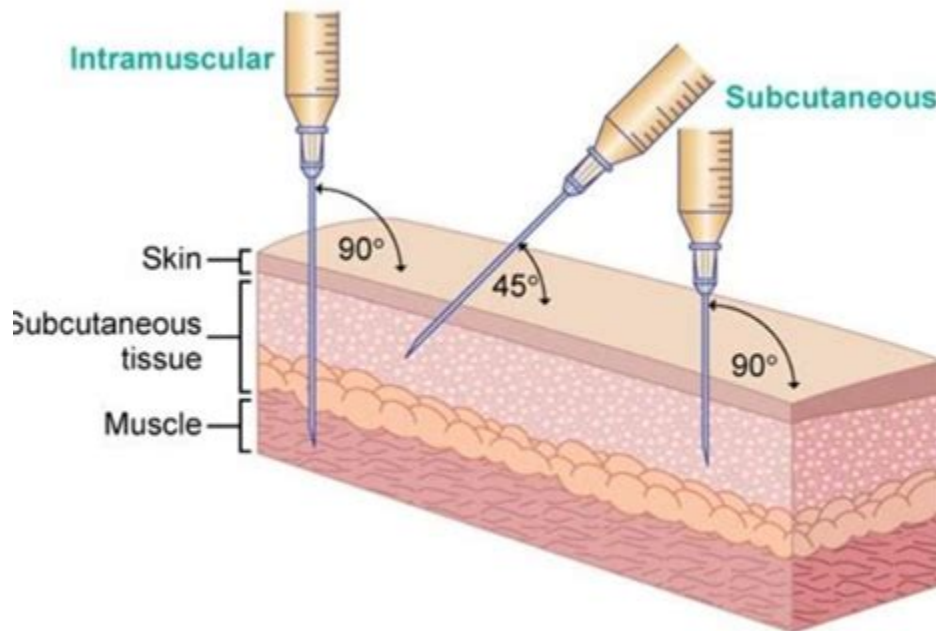
Typically, an injection-site reaction is considered to be any pain, swelling, rash, bleeding, or redness that occurs at the site of an injection, although, serious reactions can occur (see sidebar 1).² A small amount of pain or redness is expected with an intramuscular (IM) or subcutaneous injection, and a warning to this effect is included in .

What causes a lump after a subcutaneous injection? There is a certain element of trauma and inflammation after an injection, which may lead to the formation of a lump under the skin. The amount and intensity of the inflammation can be a result of many factors: Repeated injections at or near the same site The amount of medication injected

Short answer: Painful lump after pellet insertion A painful lump can occur after the insertion of hormone pellets, which are small, rice-sized pellets containing hormones that are implanted under the skin. This can be caused by inflammation or infection at the site of insertion. Treatment may involve antibiotics, anti-inflammatory medication, warm compresses, and possibly removal

Skin lesions appeared within four weeks after the second treatment of 12 testosterone pellets; each pellet was 75 mg for a total dose of 900 mg. He received an intramuscular injection of triamcinolone (corticosteroid) from his primary care physician to treat the initial and subsequent episodes, which promptly treated the first and second reactions.

Tip 6. Massage the injection spot. Painful lump after testosterone injection can occur because the medicine is clumped up in one spot under your skin. Try to rub the spot so that oil spreads under your skin and gets absorbed. If you make an injection in your delt, put your arm on a flat surface and massage the injection area with your fingers .

How to Avoid Testosterone Injection Site Swelling or Lumps



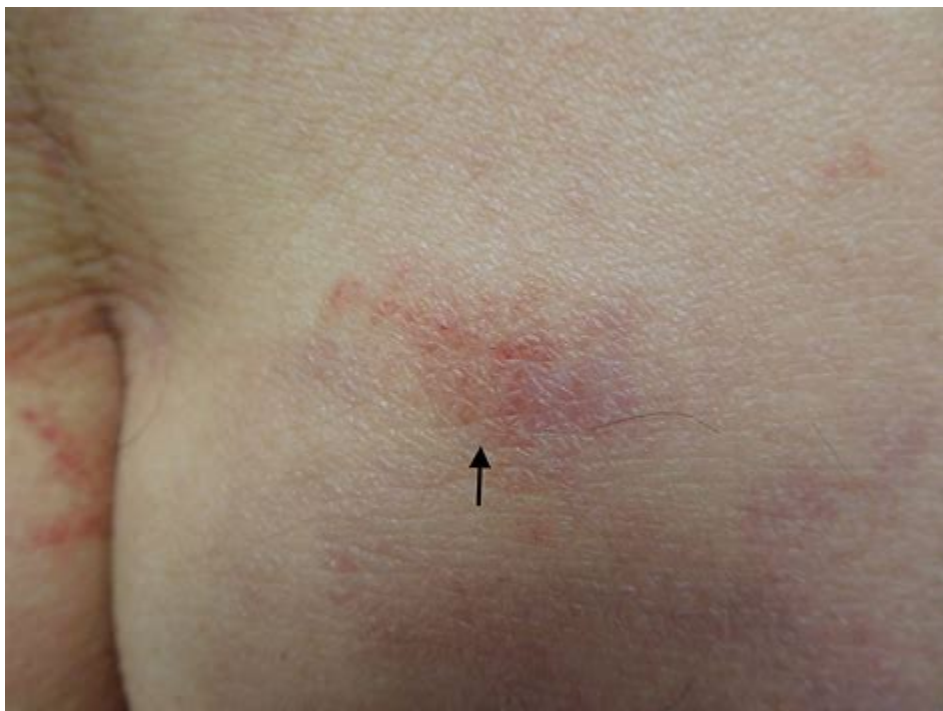
You can: Try and inject as deep Sub Q as possible. I noticed that the lumps were worse when I injected close to the skin. Second option, which worked very well for me: After you have placed finger on injection site for approx. 20-30 seconds. Rub and knead the site for 30 seconds or so. Do it again maybe an hour later.

These may include a little swelling, tenderness, pain, itching, or redness around the area where the injection was given. Typically, any minor discomfort goes away in one or two days. However, as with all medications, there can be serious adverse reactions or side effects that require prompt medical care.

The most frequently reported side effects with this drug are edema, acne, site pain, injection site erythema, cough or dyspnea during or immediately after injection. The most frequently reported side effects with testosterone topical are skin reaction (16. 1%) and allergic contact dermatitis (up to 37%).

Understanding Post-Injection Inflammation

After any injection, swelling and irritation (inflammation) can occur at the site where the needle entered the skin. This is a reaction to the needle or to the medicine that was injected. Or it may be a reaction to both. The reaction may happen right away. Or it may start hours after the injection. In most cases, the reaction isn't serious and goes away on its own.

What causes post-injection inflammation?

The most common cause is the skin or the immune system's response to the needle or the medicine. Less common causes include an allergic reaction to the medicine. In rare cases, an infection at the injection site can occur.

Symptoms of post-injection inflammation

Symptoms at the injection site may include:

- Sore when touched
- Swelling
- Itching
- Pain
- Redness
- Warmth
- Rash

Treatment for post-injection inflammation

Treatment depends on the cause and how bad the reaction is. Most post-injection inflammation is mild. It goes away on its own in a few hours or days. If treatment is needed, it may include:

- **Cold packs.** These help reduce swelling, itching, and pain.
- **Over-the-counter pain medicines.** These help reduce pain and inflammation.
- **Prescription medicine.** These treat infection.

Possible complications of post-injection inflammation

Be alert for a reaction all over your body. This may cause symptoms such as a skin rash, severe itching, or raised red bumps called hives. This kind of reaction can be serious, especially if it affects breathing. If you or your child develops symptoms away from the injection site, call your healthcare provider right away for more instructions.

Just when the memory of the pain has faded — your arm swells and turns red. If you've had injection site reactions, you may be wondering if it's an allergy or sign of something more serious. But don't swear off injections just yet. Here's what you should know about injection site reactions and how to take care of them.

Testosterone injection side effects. Get emergency medical help if you have signs of an allergic reaction: hives; difficult breathing; swelling of your face, lips, tongue, or throat. . Tell your caregivers right away if you have a tight feeling in your throat, a sudden urge to cough, or if you feel light-headed or short of breath during or shortly after receiving the injection.

Seemingly every time I end up with a sore red (sometimes quite large) lump that makes the skin surface red. This can appear 2 days-2 weeks after the injection. Wife is concerned about infection but don't seem to have any tracking yet, but the most recent lumps are very sore and very visible on skin surface. Initially I was injecting 90 degrees .

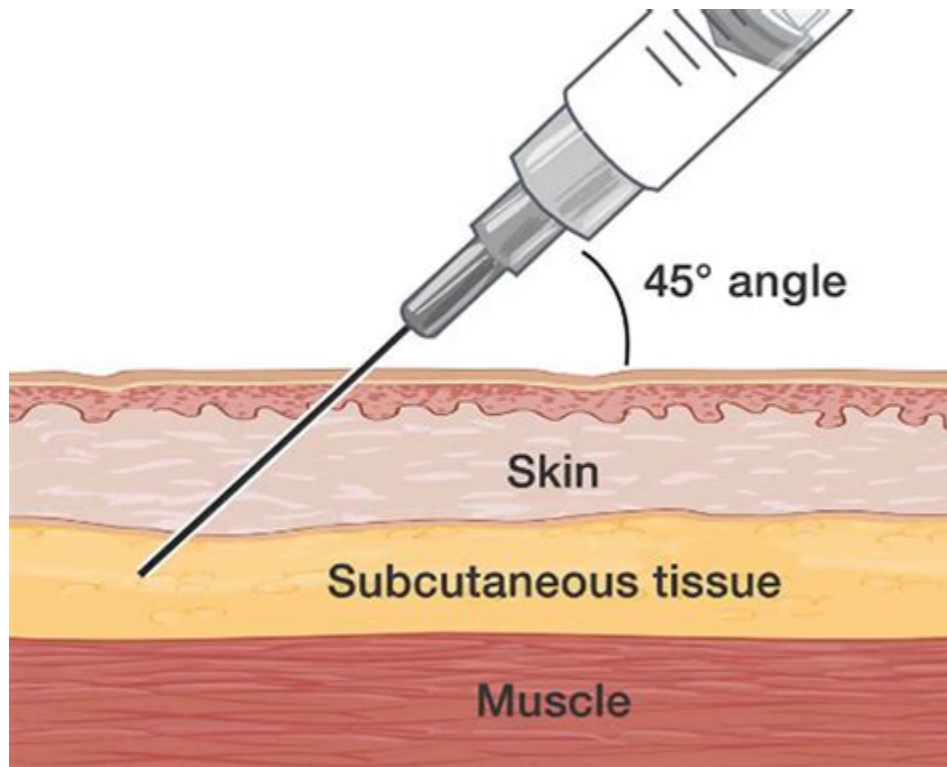
