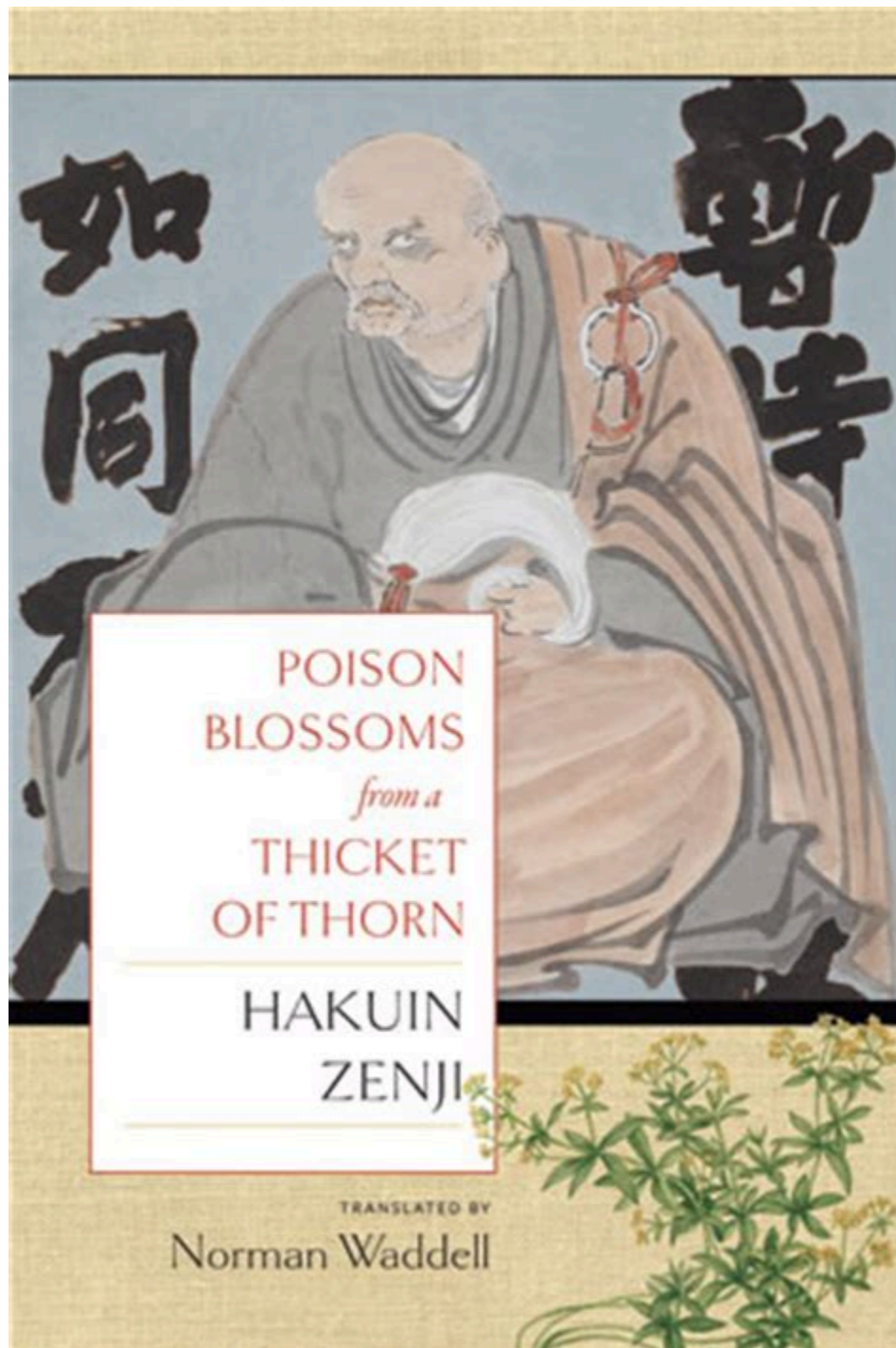

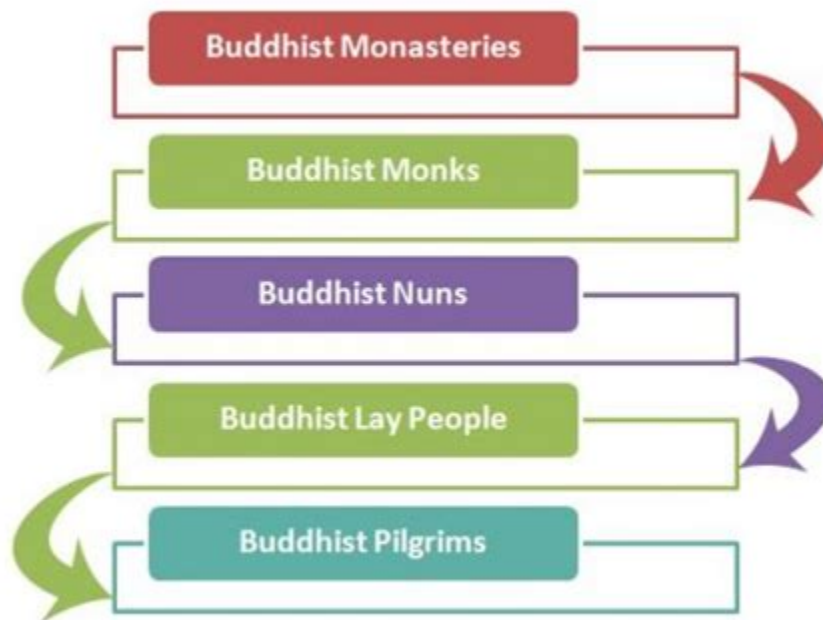

Shunryu Suzuki roshi (1904-1971) was the founder of the San Francisco Zen Center and one of the most beloved teachers in modern Buddhism. Known for his gentle and open approach based on Dōgen's (Japanese, 1200-1253, see Study Topic 10) radical non-dual reading of Zen, Suzuki roshi emphasized simple daily zazen practice and ordinary everyday living.

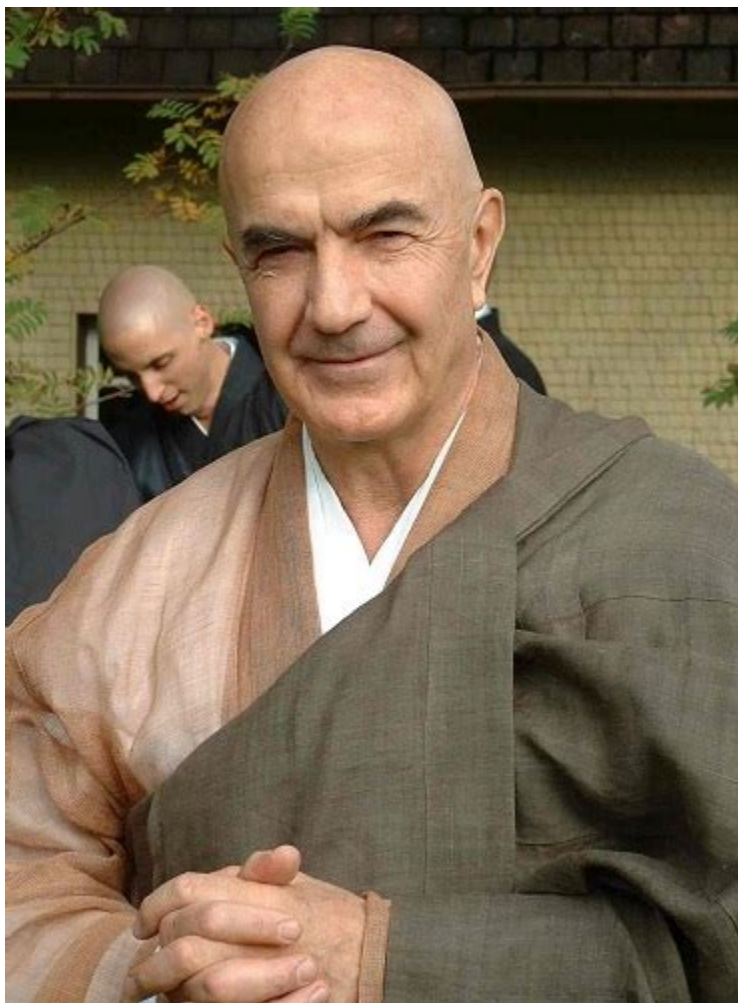

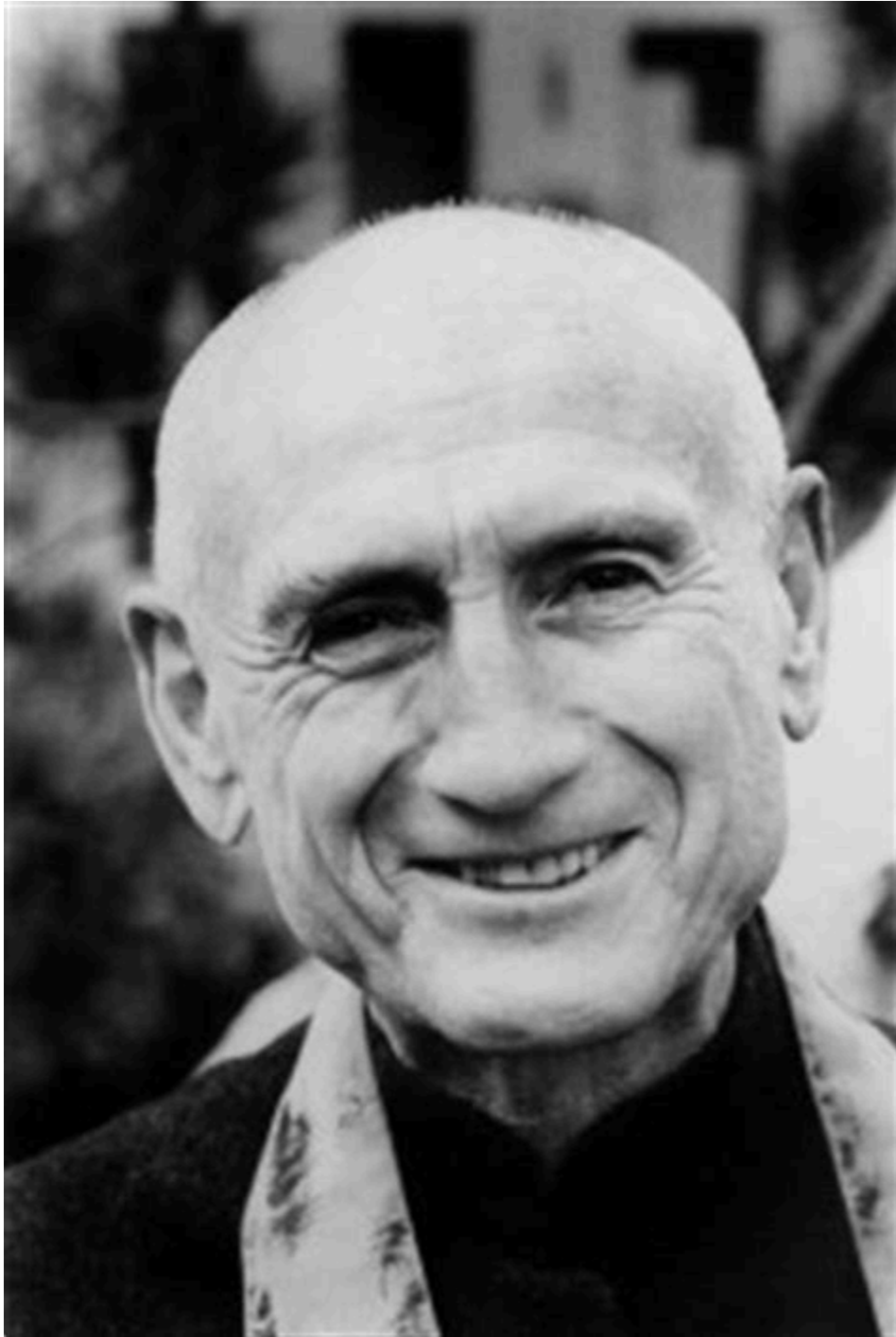
Jōza (上座) Becoming a Sōtō-Zen priest starts with shukke tokudo (出家得度). [web 3] In this ceremony, the novice receives his outfit ("inner and outer robes, belts, o-kesa, rakusu, kechimyaku (transmission chart) and eating bowls" [web 3]) and takes the precepts. One is then an Unsui, a training monk.

"Rōshi" ("old teacher") is traditionally an honorific title given to older monks and Zen teachers in Japan, though both "sensei" and "roshi" have come to denote official or semi-official ranks within some Zen schools in Japan, the United States and Europe. "Sensei" (simply "teacher") is often applied in addressing the Zen teacher or "master".

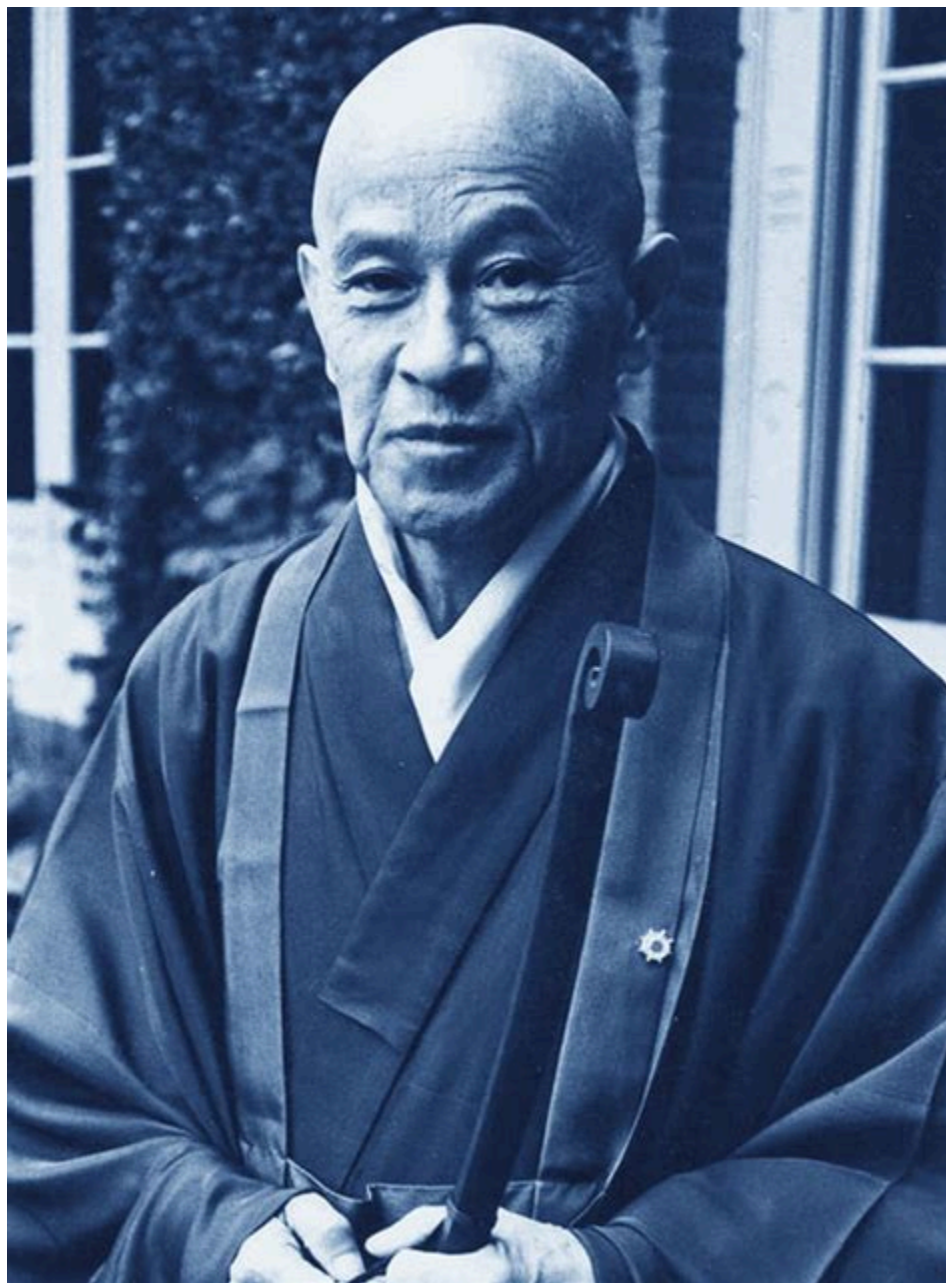

Rōshi (老師) (Japanese: "old teacher"; "old master") is a title in Zen Buddhism with different usages depending on sect and country. In Rinzai Zen, the term is reserved only for individuals who have received inka shōmei, meaning they have completed the entire kōan curriculum; this amounts to a total of fewer than 100 people at any given time.

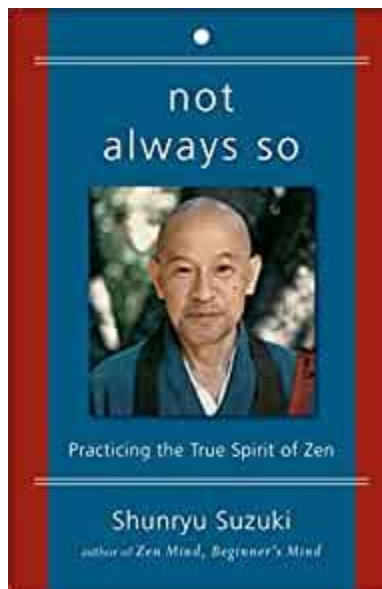

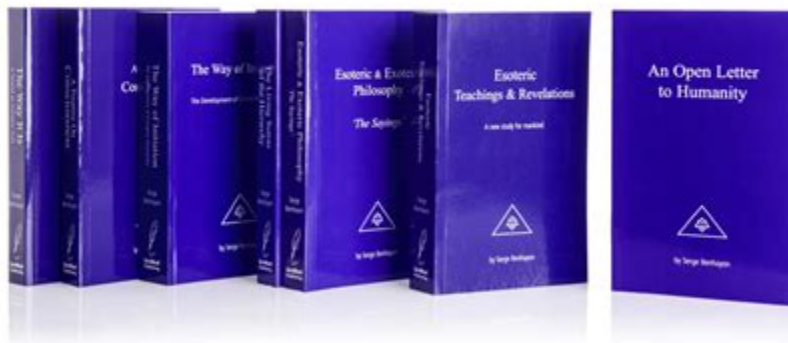
