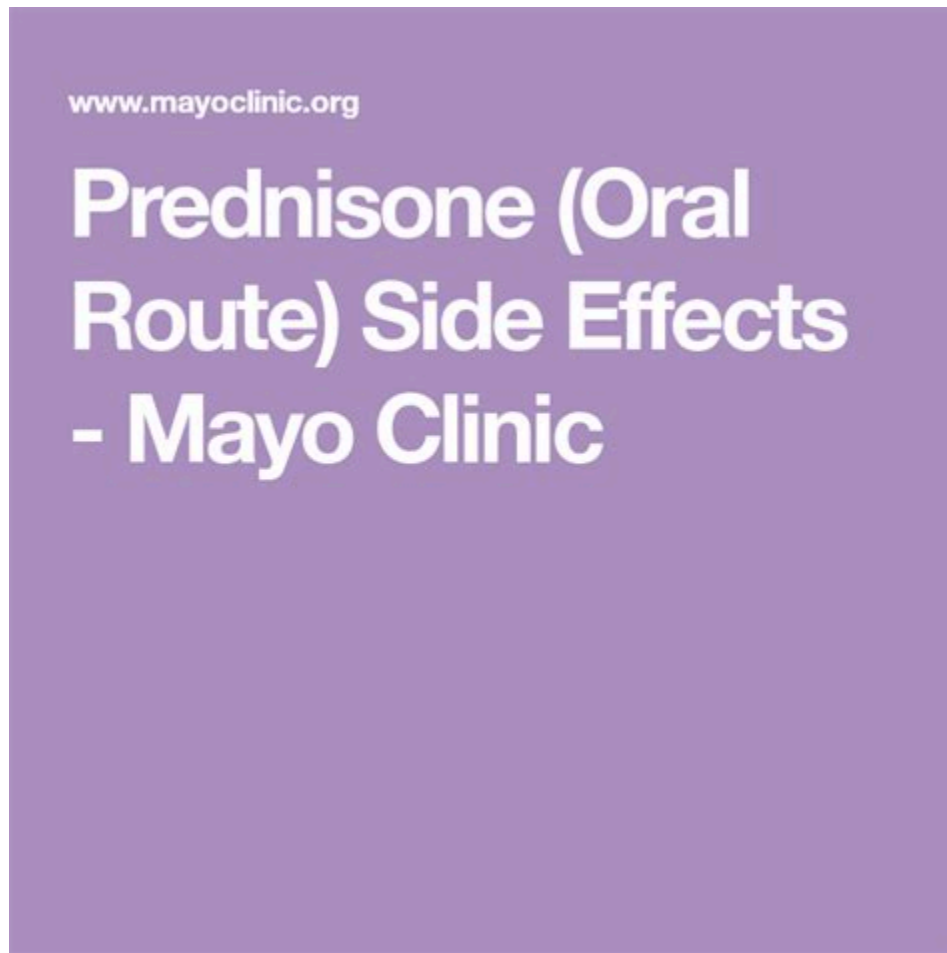

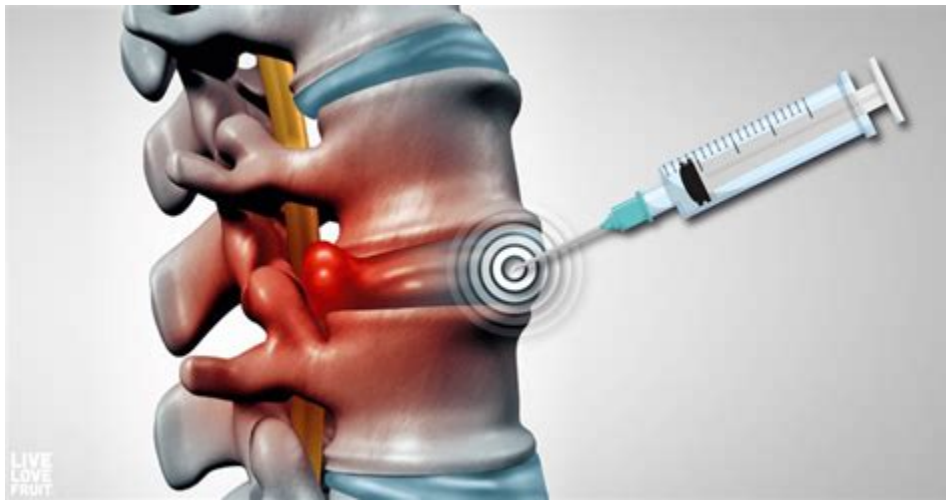

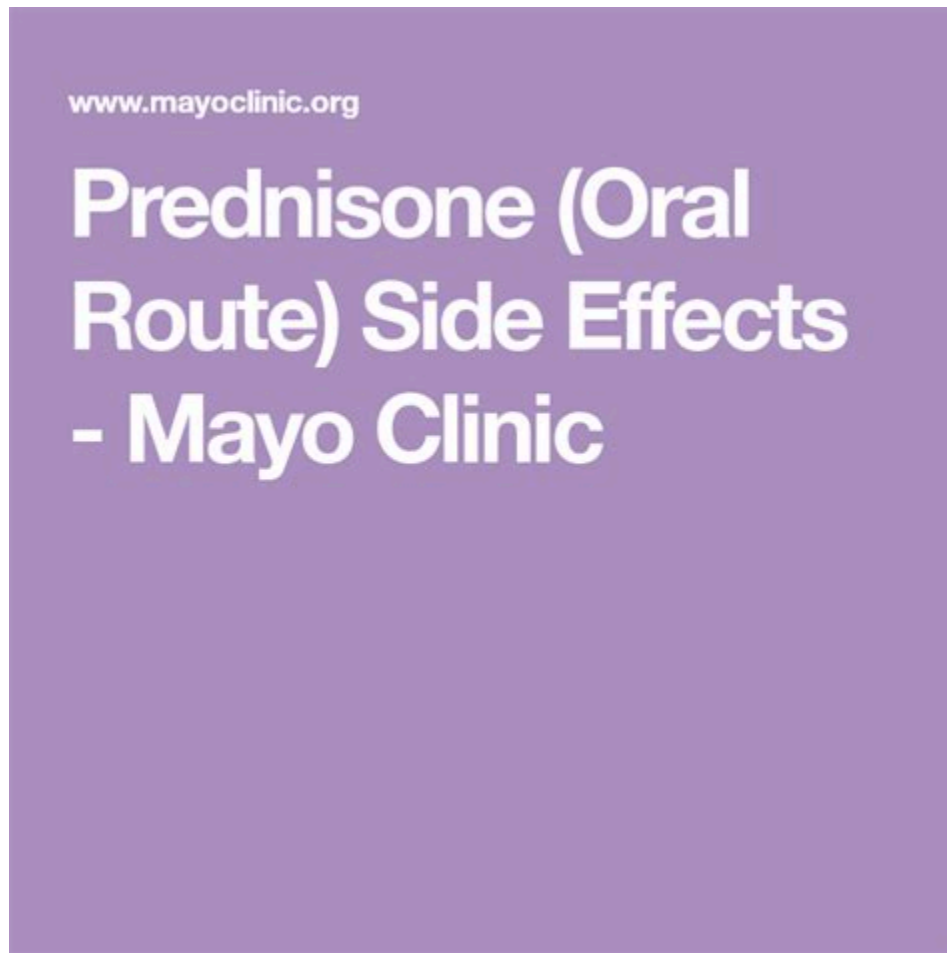

Basal joint or thumb carpometacarpal joint injection*

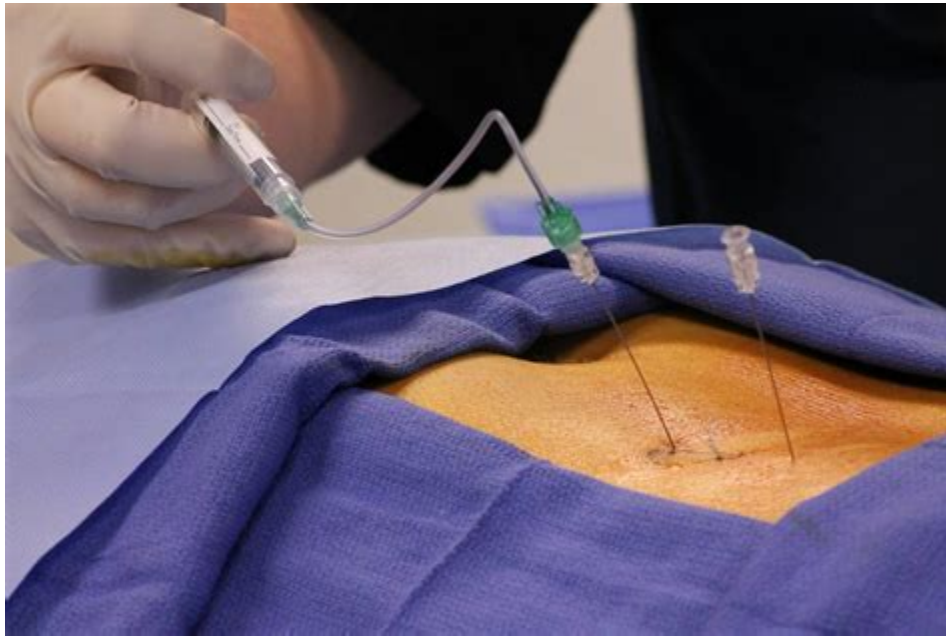


1. Clean the area with alcohol, chlorhexidine, or iodine.
2. Use ethyl chloride spray prior to injection to provide temporary injection site pain relief.
3. Palpate the metacarpal base.
4. Perform a Grind test (see page 495) to help confirm the location of the CMC joint. Traction to the joint can be helpful to increase the joint space.
5. Inject the thumb CMC joint with a mixture of lidocaine/steroid (TABLE 1²⁻⁴). The patient typically reports immediate improvement in the pain that prompted the visit.

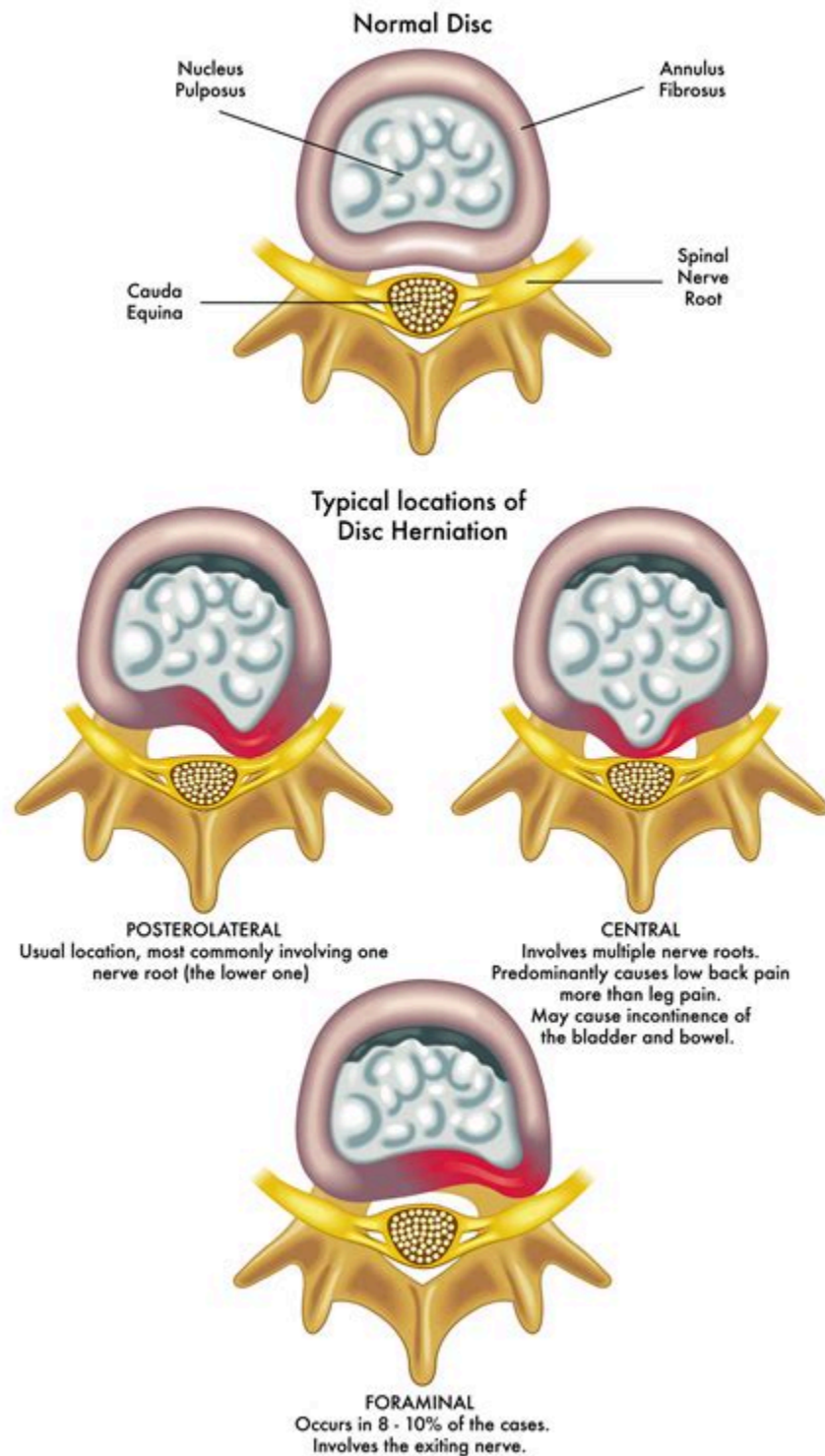
Overview Cortisone shots are injections that can help relieve pain, swelling and irritation in a specific area of your body. They're most often injected into joints — such as the ankle, elbow, hip, knee, shoulder, spine or wrist. Even the small joints in the hands or feet might benefit from cortisone shots.
