

Don't share needles and always dispose of properly Ensure all items are sealed and brand new. don't use any that are opened Only load the syringe when you're ready to inject and avoid breathing on it or having it touch any surfaces. Do not pre-load injections in an attempt to save time.

Glutes: 1-1.5 inch (For one's first purchase, unless you are exceptionally lean, it's best to stay with 1.5" needles for Glutes to make sure you inject deep enough into the muscle. ) Vento Glutes: 1 inch Delts: 1 inch (some individuals can get away with ½ inch)

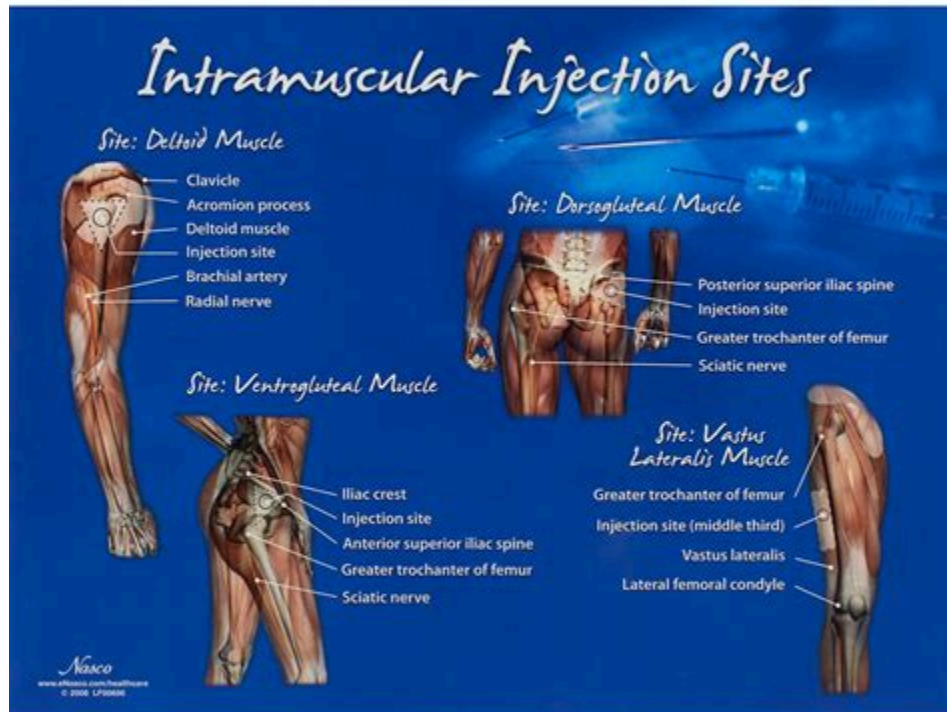

Official answer by Drugs Steroid injections can be given by several different routes depending on the condition being treated, for example: Directly into joints (intraarticular) to treat conditions such as rheumatoid arthritis or gout Directly into muscles (intramuscular) for conditions such as systemic lupus erythematosus or Behçet's disease

## Not injecting deep enough into the muscle - The Iron Den



A different stage in the process: you need to pinch your skin a bit to make it thick enough for safe, painless, and precise needle insertion; You don't need to go DEEP in the tissue and change the angle to 45 degrees. In every other aspect, subcutaneous injections are not that different from intramuscular. That's it.



## Safer injecting for steroid users - With You



Side-effects and risks. Most people have steroid injections without any side effects. They can be a little uncomfortable at the time of injection, but many people feel that this is not as bad as they feared. Occasionally people notice a flare-up in their joint pain within the first 24 hours after an injection.

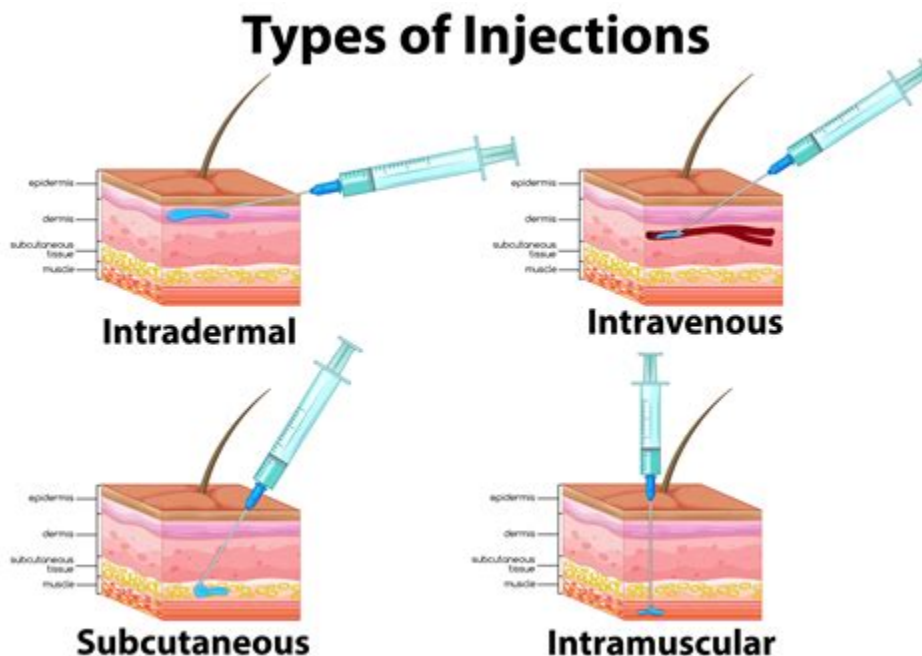

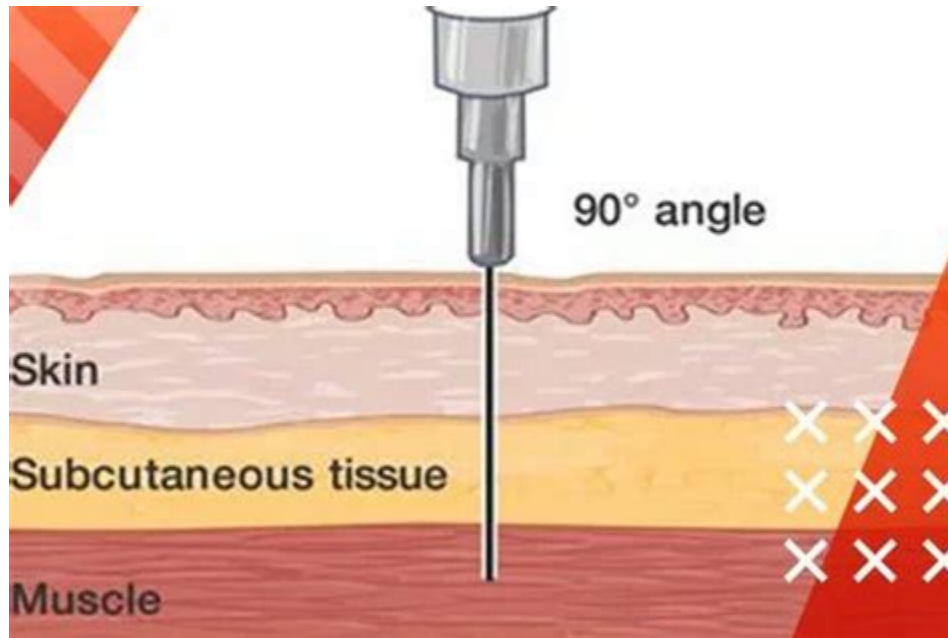
**What happens if your injection isn't deep enough into the muscle?**



Use ice on the injection site as needed to relieve pain. Don't use heating pads. Not use a bathtub, hot tub

or whirlpool for two days. It's OK to shower. Watch for signs of infection, including increasing pain, redness and swelling lasting more than 48 hours. Results. Results of cortisone shots typically depend on the reason for the treatment.

Lumbar epidural steroid injections are usually safe, but there are risks of certain side effects and complications. Although rare, risks and complications that apply to lumbar ESI injections include: Low blood pressure, which can make you feel lightheaded. Severe headache caused by spinal fluid leakage.

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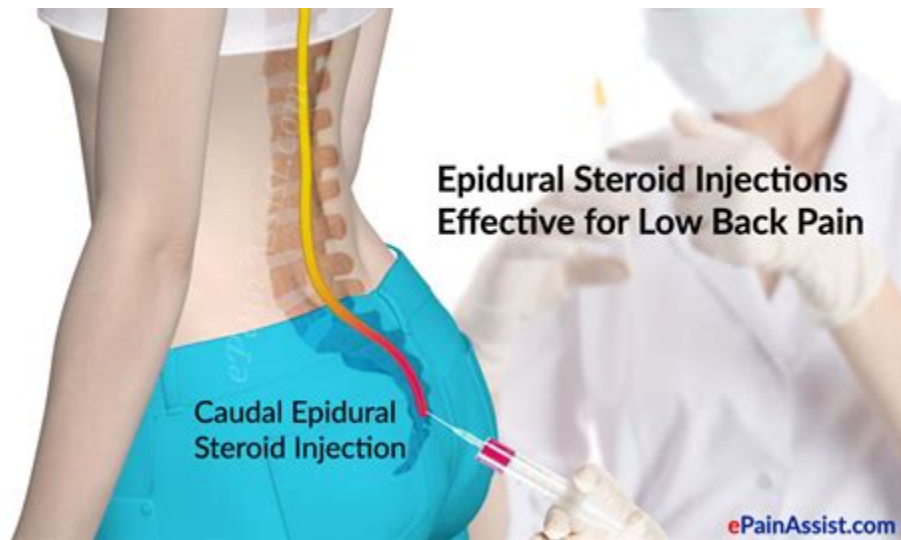

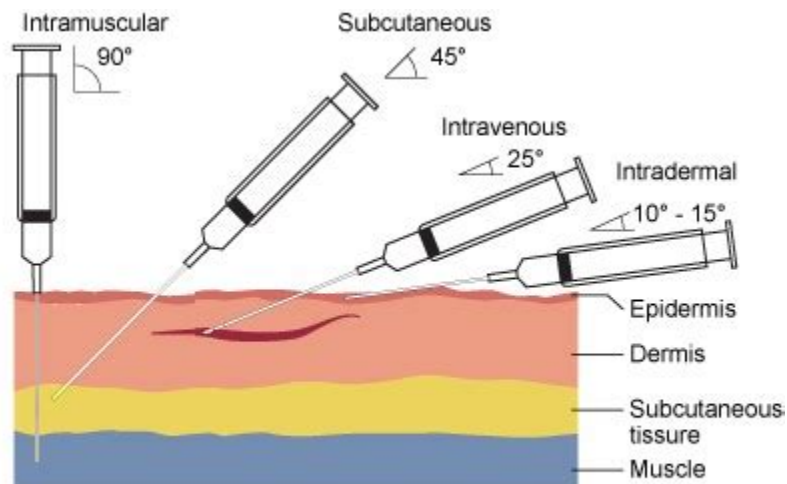

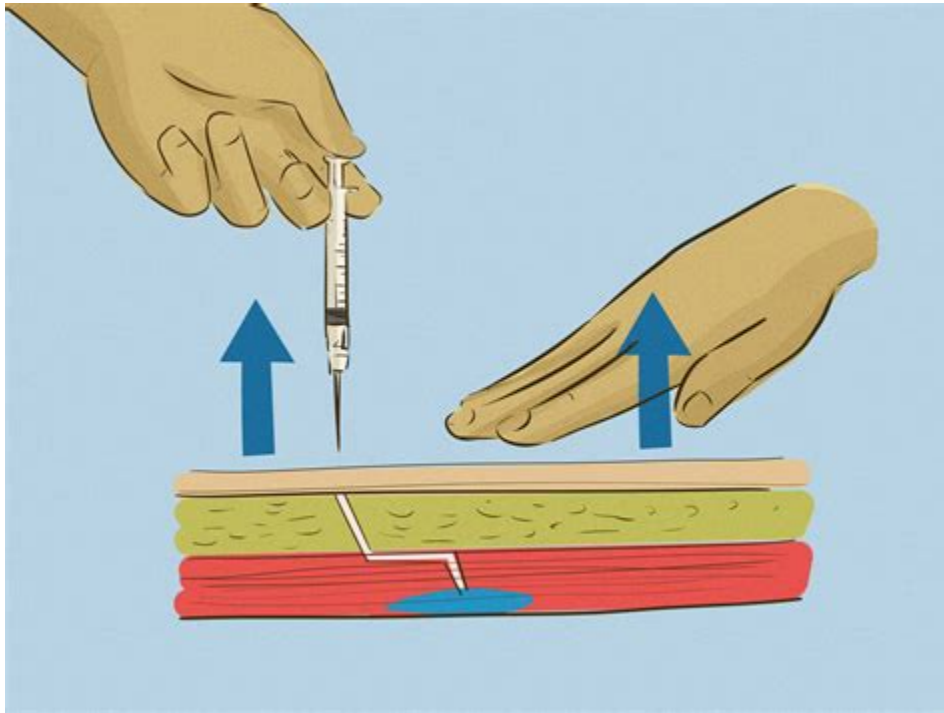

## The importance of injecting vaccines into muscle - PMC



Put the injection in the center of the triangle of the muscle. This should be 1 to 2 inches (2.5 to 5 centimeters) below that bone. Buttocks: DO NOT use this site for a child under 3 years old, because there is not enough muscle here yet. Measure this site carefully, because an injection given in the wrong place could hit a nerve or blood vessel.

## Giving an IM (intramuscular) injection - Mount Sinai Health System



The injection technique and needle size both determine how deep a substance is injected. Injection technique involves stretching the skin flat before inserting the needle or pinching a fold of skin before injection, which may necessitate the use of longer needles. Pediatric	Infants < 18 months	• Vastus lateralis muscle (<0.5 mL vol.)	7/8" - 1"	25 - 27 G	90°
	Children (>18 months and walking to 18 years)	• Deltoid muscle • Ventrogluteal site • Dorsogluteal site—not recommended for <3 years • Vastus lateralis muscle	7/8" - 1 1/4"	22 - 25 G	90°
Adult	> 18 years	• Deltoid muscle, Ventrogluteal site—may be best site for cachectic adults • Dorsogluteal site—avoid in obese adults • Vastus lateralis muscle	1" - 1 1/2" (up to 3" for large adults)	19 - 25 G	90°

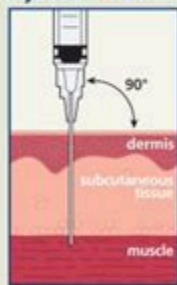

## Intramuscular (IM) Injection Guidelines:

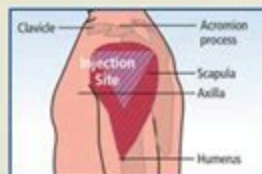
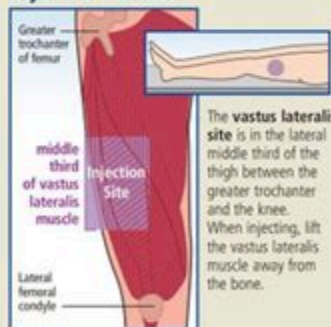
### Injection Route:



### Injection Procedure:

- Spread the skin taut, (except in vastus lateralis which requires lifting the muscle) and insert the needle at a 90° angle.
- Pull back plunger slightly. If blood appears, remove needle, dispose properly and prepare a new injection.
- If no blood is present inject medication slowly.

### Injection Sites:





These included: about 7% to 8% of people getting steroid injections seem to worsen, with their arthritis accelerating "beyond the expected rate". bone damage (called osteonecrosis) (in about 1% of people).
