

Steroid injections may be used for people with rheumatoid arthritis or other causes of joint pain and swelling such as osteoarthritis, gout or frozen shoulder. Steroid injections may also be used for inflammation of soft tissues, such as: Bursitis, prepatellar bursitis, olecranon bursitis. Tendinopathies eg, Achilles tendinopathy.

Rheumatoid arthritis Common Use A corticosteroid injection may quickly reduce inflammation in the body, offering knee pain relief that can last for two to three months, and sometimes longer. The temporary pain relief may provide an opportunity to engage in physical therapy, attend an important life event, or postpone knee replacement surgery.

Epidural Steroid Injections: Risks and Side Effects



The injected cortisone medication can crystallize inside the body. The crystals can cause pain and inflammation that is worse than the pain and inflammation caused by the condition being treated. This side effect is called a cortisone flare. A flare typically lasts one or two days and can be treated with rest and intermittent cold packs.
